Dear Friends:

Since 2008, this grassroots local charity has been collecting, refurbishing, cleaning and giving away wheelchairs, walkers, bathing equipment and much more. STLHELP:

- Added two STLHELP HUBs (lending closets) in the communities we serve to increase access. Recruited six more HELP HUB locations to open in 2024.
 Increased the overall number of people served to 2207 in 2023 from 1654
- individuals in 2022, an increase of 25%.
- Increased the number of people served in the City of St. Louis City from 367 in 2022 to 492 in 2023, an increase of 25%.
- Doubled the amount of home medical equipment (HME) diverted from landfills from 54.87 in 2022 to 110 tons in 2023, an increase of 55%.
